

Rules for participating in CS-Lab CTF Team (C2L4B)

- 1. Goals:** C2L4B is a group of students from the Departamento de Engenharia Informática (DEI) from Universidade de Coimbra (UC), created with the purpose of learning cybersecurity-related topics while participating in Capture the Flag (CTF) competitions.
- 2. Membership:** Participating in this group is voluntary and open to everyone in the DEI@UC community that accepts these rules.
- 3. Ethics and Conduct:** Ethics is a must to this group. Everyone should behave according to the highest standards.
- 4. Legal Compliance:** The members of the group accept that the techniques and methodologies learned and the knowledge acquired while participating in events related with C2L4B and CS-Lab should not be used for any action contrary to the law.
- 5. Hacking and Vulnerabilities:** Hacking systems and exploiting vulnerabilities is an **ILLEGAL** task and must not be performed unless in very particular circumstances and if explicitly authorized by the company, organization, entity or person that owns or manages the target systems.
- 6. Liability:** The Universidade de Coimbra, Departamento de Engenharia Informática, Centro de Informática e Sistemas da Universidade de Coimbra (CISUC), affiliated research institutes, and anyone affiliated with these should not be made accountable for any such usage that is contrary to the law.
- 7. GDPR and Personal Data:** In accordance to the GDPR, I explicitly authorize the collection of personal data, such as name, e-mail, Github and Discord usernames and the publication of other information such as videos, images and photos when related to activities associated with C2L4B Team
